

Practical Title: Paper helicopters investigation

Focus and Principles: Focus the recording on the learning objectives.

Equipment: Paper helicopter templates, range of types of paper (e.g. newspaper, tracing paper, card, normal paper), post-it notes (square), paper clips, metre rules, measuring tapes, timers, scissors
As well as the templates, post-it notes are another simple way (only two cuts required) to create helicopters.

Suggested pupil group size: 3-4
